HOLY SPIRIT & OUR LADY'S ACTIVITIES

PAPAL VISIT: The Holy Father will be visiting the UK from 16th -19th September 2010. The visit has both State and pastoral aspects. He comes at the invitation of Her Majesty the Queen and the Prime Minister, and the visit will include a number of state engagements. There will also be a number of pastoral events, culminating with the beatification of Cardinal Newman at a major open air Mass at Coventry Airport on Sunday 19th September. Please pray for the Holy Father and for the success of the visit itself. The costs for the pastoral aspects of the visit are substantial, around £7m, and must be met by the Church. Archbishop Vincent Nichols and our Bishops have asked that each parish in the country holds a special collection to help meet these costs and the collection will be taken up in the Holy Spirit and Our Lady's parishes on the weekend of 29th/30th May. Please be as generous as you can. Gift Aid envelopes will be available.

NEW TRANSLATION OF THE ROMAN MISSAL: You may be aware that later this year, a new translation of the prayers and responses we use at Mass will come into use. Much work is being done in preparation for this and training is being offered by the Diocesan Education Service, Youth Service and Vocations Service. They would like to offer preparation and training to those who work with our children and young people in parishes throughout

the diocese. This is an opportunity to not only prepare for the changes to how we celebrate the Eucharist, but also renew our understanding of liturgy with children and young people; revisit good principles and learn from each other's experience. A Training and Preparation session has been arranged locally on Sunday 11th July from 1.00 pm to 4.00 pm at Good Shepherd Parish, Arnold, Nottingham. The afternoon is open to **catechists working on First Holy Communion, Confirmation and RCIA preparation, parish youth leaders, priests and liturgical ministers**.
