**PADLEY INTERDIOCESAN PILGRIMAGE TO PADLEY** will take place this year on Sunday 11<sup>th</sup> July. Pilgrims meet at 3.00 pm at Grindlford Station and will be led to the Chapel by Bishop John Rawsthorne and Bishop Malcolm McMahon where Mass will be celebrated at 3.30 pm. The speaker this year will be the Archbishop of Westminster, the Most Rev Vincent Nichols. Parking at the Chapel is very limited, but there is ample parking at the station, where stewards will be on duty to assist you.

**PAPAL VISIT:** The Holy Father will be visiting the UK from 16<sup>th</sup> -19<sup>th</sup> September 2010. The visit has both State and pastoral aspects. He comes at the invitation of Her Majesty the Queen and the Prime Minister, and the visit will include a number of state engagements. There will also be a number of pastoral events, culminating with the beatification of Cardinal Newman at a major open air Mass at Coventry Airport on Sunday 19<sup>th</sup> September.
