## HOLY SPIRIT & OUR LADY'S ACTIVITIES

**PADLEY PILGRIMAGE:** This year's pilgrimage, on 11<sup>th</sup> July 2010, marks the 113<sup>th</sup> annual Inter Diocesan Pilgrimage to Padley in honour of the two martyr priests, Nicholas Garlick and Robert Ludlam. The Pilgrimage will be led to the Chapel by Bishop John Rawsthorne and Bishop Malcolm McMahon. **This year's speaker will be The Archbishop of Westminster, the Most Rev Vincent Nichols.** Pilgrims meet at 3.00 pm at Grindleford Station (postcode S32 2JA) and will be led to the Chapel, where Mass will be celebrated at 3.30pm. Please bring your own folding chairs for the Mass. Parking at the chapel is very limited but there is ample parking at the station. Stewards will be on duty to assist you. If you should wish to drop anyone off at the chapel please do so and then park at the station. Access to the grounds is unfortunately not suitable for wheelchairs. Many pilgrims arrive early at the chapel and enjoy a picnic in the grounds. Toilets will be available at the Peak Park Ranger Station opposite the chapel.
