We found that a massive 88% of the rubbish from the social centre could be recycled but is just going in the skip then on to landfill. We have also visited Rushcliffe Country Park which really helped us appreciate the wonderful world God has given us. We are now working on an action plan including ideas like recycling bins in the social centre and encouraging people to read the newsletter online instead of taking a paper copy... look out for our posters and pick up a copy of our eco-code to post up at home!
