### **POPE BENEDICT'S VISIT TO THE UK:**

Details of the arrangements for attending the Beatification Mass in Birmingham have now been announced. We have been given very tight deadlines for allocating places at the Mass and your response is therefore **NEEDED URGENTLY**.

### **THE BEATIFICATION MASS: SUNDAY 19<sup>th</sup> SEPTEMBER 2010 COFTON PARK, BIRMINGHAM:**

Travel to this Mass is **only** allowed on coaches which have been organised centrally by The Diocese. **There is no access for private cars, coaches etc.** Each parish has been allocated **15 pilgrim places** and a place for a priest. We have been asked to try and ensure that young people are represented, and for this reason a minimum of 2 places will be allocated for school age children. Minors have to be accompanied by an adult, so any young person applying for a place must also nominate a parent or guardian to travel with them. There is no lower age limit, but the age of the young person and name of the parent or guardian should be indicated on the sheet. We would love to have some of our servers, young musicians and youth group members going to see the Pope, so we would especially encourage you to put your names down. Similarly, if you wish to apply but need a carer to accompany you, please provide the name and details of the carer on the sheet. The coach will depart from the new Becket School, West Bridgford.

The Mass commences at 9.30 am and every pilgrim has to be in place by 8.30 am, so a **very early start is anticipated - probably around 6.00 am** but detailed travel arrangements will be passed on nearer the time. Each pilgrim will be asked to **contribute £25**, which includes the cost of coach travel and a pilgrim pack with what is needed for the Mass. **If you wish to go to the Beatification Mass on Sunday 19<sup>th</sup> September, please put your details on the list in the church porch urgently.** The list is open until noon on Sunday 25<sup>th</sup> July. **If numbers are oversubscribed, we will have a draw for the 15 places and the names of successful parishioners will be posted on the church noticeboard.** If you have any queries about the arrangements, please contact David Paton on 9231397 or on [David.Paton@nottingham.ac.uk](mailto:David.Paton@nottingham.ac.uk).
