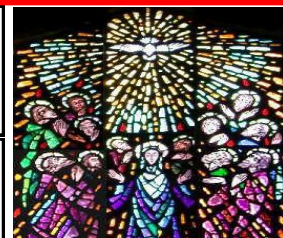

DBS RENEWAL CHECKS

FOR PARISH MINISTRY VOLUNTEERS

The Diocese now requires everybody in ministry with children or adults to renew their DBS (formerly CRB) disclosure if their existing disclosure was issued pre June 2012.

DBS disclosures are now obtained through an online application process. Some of you have been contacted already by your Parish Ministry group leaders about this.

It is important that all Parish volunteers do their DBS renewals as soon as possible.
