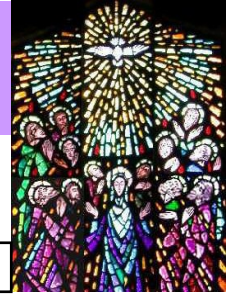

## NOTTINGHAM CITIZENS RESULTS OF PARISH CONSULTATION

Thank you to everyone who took part in last weeks parish vote for the issues we feel most concern us, the response was fantastic. The results are: Mental health (covering all ages), Young people (to include educational attainment), Employment conditions (including poverty). Many people identified that there was crossover and so it was agreed to include related issues into the top 3 where they fitted closely. As a parish we will be supporting most closely the Mental health and Young people's issues.

On Nov 14<sup>th</sup> we have an opportunity to affect the focus of these workstreams and you are warmly invited to come and join in the discussions. Please speak Theresa Brennan the H. S. Representative and John Murray at Our Lady of Grace.

**Share the Journey-** Thank you for taking part in a Share the Journey walk. Every mile that you have walked has helped to send a message to world leaders that they must step up too. They need to act with courage and compassion when they agree ambitious new UN agreements on refugees and migration.

In June 2018, the world-wide Catholic community reached our target of walking 24, 900 miles. Since then we've walked round the world another three times! Now we are on our fifth leg around the world. **Parish Pilgrimage to Lourdes and Nevers by Coach**

**June 15th –June 22nd 2019**

The cost is £565 per person. The price includes Coach and Ferry travel, overnight stay with Bed and Breakfast at the Welcome Break hotel in Orleans on the way out, full board at the Hotel Irlande in Lourdes, half board at the Kyriad Hotel in Nevers on the way back. In addition to this there's an optional excursion to Gavarnie, a Ski resort in the Pyrenees.

The cost of the Pilgrimage is £345. Next year's pilgrimage is a day longer than in recent years as we will begin travelling to Alencon to visit and have Mass at the place that St Therese was born. We will then follow in her footsteps with a guided visit to the Cathedral in Lisieux, to the Basilica dedicated to St Therese, to the house where she grew up and to the museum and to the Carmel where she lived and died.
