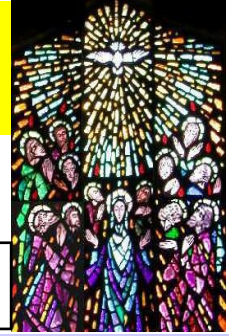

Halima is eight years old Her family fed violence in Myanmar along with more than 500, 000 Rohingya people. She is now in a refugee camp in Bangladesh. Halima's mother Fatima, says the family have been surviving on rice and potatoes and as a result of the children being malnourished. Cafod's local partner Caritas Bangladesh, is providing emergency aid to many families like Halima's.



The CAFOD group would like to thank all parishioners, parish groups and St Edmund Campion school for supporting the 'Share the Journey' campaign. We have a board at the back of church where we have recorded the amount of miles walked so far for this parish, please feel free to record your name, the miles you have walked and the date you completed your walk onto the footprints attached to the board.
