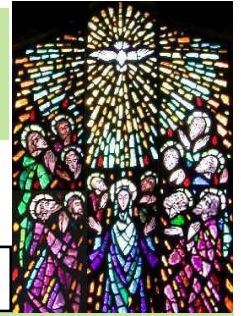

## OUR LADY OF THE VISITATION:
