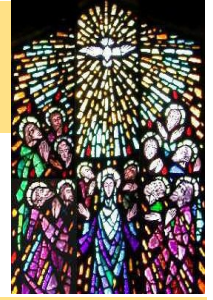

Rushcliffe Borough Council are planning to advertise Lutterell Hall for development removing vital services from West Bridgford and surrounding areas. Some of our local community groups will have nowhere to go if the hall is sold. Also a lot of church halls like our Social centre are sometimes fully booked up during the week with other groups, so cannot accommodate these groups. Churches in West Bridgford are in discussion with the council and the community about the hall. But we need more support.
