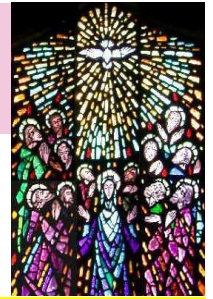

Save Lutterell Hall



Rushcliffe Borough Council are planning to advertise Lutterell Hall for development removing vital services from West Bridgford and surrounding areas.

A meeting was held at Rushcliffe Arena 11th June where residents complained. But it seems the council have moved a step closer to selling it, according to the Nottingham Post, as the council are considering to market it, the hall has also been freshly decorated in the past two weeks as well.

Lutterell hall is a beautiful period building built in 1929 and situated in a prime location with easy access from public transport and on site parking. It has been owned for the last 40 years by Rushcliffe Borough Council and is a hub for our local community. It is also well used, including: St. Giles Playgroup, Community group meetings, Exercise / dance classes, A Singing group, Sunday school, Children's parties, Wedding receptions, Adult celebrations, Dance Classes.

Some of these local community groups will have nowhere to go if the hall is sold. Also a lot of church halls like our Social centre are sometimes fully booked up during the week with other groups, so cannot accommodate these groups. Churches in West Bridgford are in discussion with the council and the community about the hall. But we need more support.
