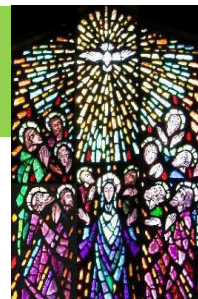

### The 33rd Rosary Rally 1st September

The 33rd Rosary Rally takes place this year on the 1st September 2019 at Mount St Bernard Abbey, Leicestershire. You are warmly invited to join in the Rally to pray for 'World Peace and Young People'. The Principle Celebrant is Fr Colin Patey (Retired



Priest of the Nottingham Diocese) and the day will commence at 2pm with concelebrated Mass, followed by picnic and refreshments in the lovely grounds of the monastery. Resuming at 4pm the second part of the Rally will consist of the crowning of a statue of Our Lady, a procession with Rosary and hymns with a choir, followed by the Blessed Sacrament, blessing of the sick and concluding with Benediction. Bring a folding chair or stool.

**Lutterell Hall Update**

Thank you to all those who have signed the paper petition and the online Change.org one too.



We have some good news Rushcliffe Borough Council have granted an application to list Lutterell Hall in West Bridgford as an Asset of Community Value. The application made by St Giles' Preschool, who are based at the site, means the building cannot be sold without giving a community group the opportunity to purchase it.

If a group wishes to buy Lutterell Hall, this application means they can trigger a six-month period in which they are given time to raise the money to purchase the building should the authority seek to relinquish ownership of the venue.

The council will consider expressions of interest from community groups that then can be appraised with the options to retain Lutterell Hall for community use, as agreed at its Cabinet meeting in June.

However, we are yet to hear how money will be raised to save the hall. We will keep you updated.
