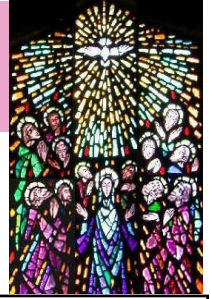

### The 33rd Rosary Rally 1st September



The 33rd Rosary Rally takes place this year on the 1st September 2019 at Mount St Bernard Abbey, Leicestershire. You are warmly invited to join in the Rally to pray for 'World Peace and Young People'. The Principle Celebrant is Fr Colin Patey (Retired Priest of the Nottingham Diocese) and the day will commence at 2pm with concelebrated Mass, followed by picnic and refreshments in the lovely grounds of the monastery. Resuming at 4pm the second part of the Rally will consist of the crowning of a statue of Our Lady, a procession with Rosary and hymns with a choir, followed by the Blessed Sacrament, blessing of the sick and concluding with Benediction. Bring a folding chair or stool.

Mount St Bernard Abbey is situated on the Oaks Road near Coalville (Postcode LE67 5UL). About 5 miles from Junction 23 of the M1 and off the A512 in the direction of Ashby, signposted from Shepshed.

#### The Cotgrave Open Gardens event results

Community events that help local charities are always welcomed and a great time was had on a late June weekend (22 & 23 June). The sun shone, folk flooded in, some from far outside the pretty town of Cotgrave.

The 26 residents who opened their gardens deserve a big thank you for their enthusiasm and hard work. Their efforts made the event the success it was and allowed the visitors to explore the beautiful and varied gardens on display. Visitors also enjoyed the opportunity to buy plants, jams and preserves.

Over £1,700 was raised during the weekend and this generosity allowed us to present £1,600 to the Dove Cottage Day Hospice charity on 8 August. Many local people have used this excellent facility, based in Stathern. Our donation will help to fund their monthly drop-in sessions for people with dementia and their carers who live in the Nottingham area.
