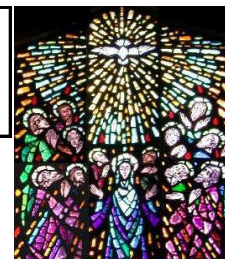

New Advice on booking Family Pews at Mass

When you book at family Pew can you please book 'Seats' as well, otherwise we will not have seats taken off our booking system.

If you book a family Pew, you need to put how many Seats (people) are on the Pew.

You can only book a **family Pew and up to 6 seats** on the booking system.

You can either **book single places up to 3 people**, or book one **Family Pew for 4-6 people**.

Please do not book two pews if you do not need them.

The deadline for online Mass place bookings is **23 hours and 50 minutes** before the Mass starts.

Proposed Incinerator in Ratcliffe-on-Soar



UK incinerators released 11m tonnes of CO2 in 2017. It is said that each tonne of plastic incinerated results in the release of around 1.43 tonnes of CO2.

A typical waste incinerator built in 2020 would release 2.8 million tonnes of fossil CO2 over its 30-year lifetime.

DEFRA's chief scientific adviser, Sir Ian Boyd. "I think that incineration is not a good direction to go in. If you are investing many tens of millions, probably hundreds of millions, in urban waste incineration plants, and those plants are going to have a 30-year to 40-year lifespan, you have to have the waste streams to keep them supplied. That it is a market pull on waste. It encourages the production of waste. It encourages the production of residual waste. It encourages people to think that we can throw what could be valuable materials, if we were to think about them innovatively, into a furnace and burn them."
