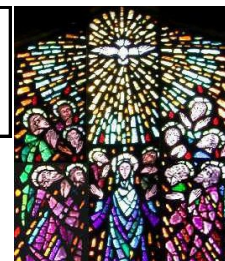

New Advice on booking Family Pews at Mass

When you book at family Pew can you please book 'Seats' as well, otherwise we will not have seats taken off our booking system. **Please ignore the information box.**

If you book a family Pew, you need to put how many **Seats** (people) are on the Pew. A few of you are forgetting to do this still. Please book a Pew and Seats for family members on that Pew.

You can only book a **family Pew and up to 6 seats** on the booking system.
