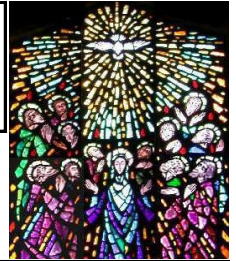

### Holy Spirit SVP ( Putting Concern into Action)

Our St Vincent De Paul society conference in the parish have been doing vital work during the Covid-19 pandemic. We have been supporting parishioners and people in our community by writing to and phoning those isolated at home providing friendship, a listening ear and a link with the parish. Some members and a group of volunteers who are supporting our SVP work in the parish have been doing errands and shopping.



We continue to support three young families with the means to buy food and clothing and we have continued with our regular support of the Friary and Emmanuel house. Our conference managed to get a grant to help towards the cost of a funeral and for a young student to support him in continuing his studies. We had a great response from the parish to help furnish a home and Provide bedding and clothes. We have been able to support our twin conferences in India who do amazing work with the poor and disadvantaged in their communities.

The needs grow as we go into recession with unemployment, homelessness and food poverty on the rise and we need help to give assistance to those who are in need. Our earlier appeal for funds was a big help and meant that we could reach out to many in our community. We thank you for your continued generosity.

Today we are appealing for people to become members of our SVP conference in the parish. We are trying to adapt to the times and now meet via Zoom once a month and communicate regularly by email.
