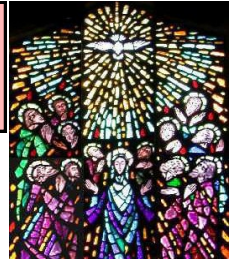

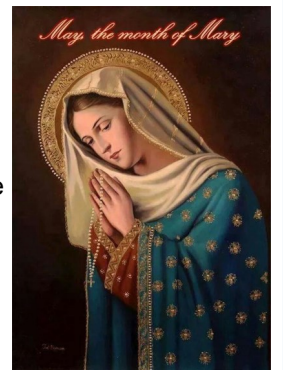
OUR LADY OF VISITATION-
