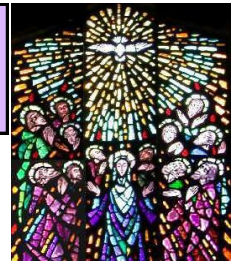

Masses At The Holy Spirit

We are open for daily Masses and private prayer during the week, however our capacity will remain the same with 50 seats. We have been advised by the Diocese remain with two metre distancing.

You will be able to attend public weekday Masses without booking a place.

However, we kindly ask you use the NHS App and scan your phone on the QR code in church or confirm to a Steward your attendance by giving your name and contact number.

You must sanitize your hands before entering church and wear a mask.

For week day Masses you will only be able to sit on the left hand side of the church or middle pews. You must not sit on pews in Our Lady's chapel.

The seats in our Lady's chapel are for private prayer during the day only. **You must** sanitize your hands before entering church and wear a face covering.

For weekend Masses you will still need to book a place with the Diocesan online booking system.

ELEVENTH SUNDAY OF THE YEAR

Must tell my Neighbour' #EUTellThem: do you know a neighbour, a friend or family member who is either an EU, EEA (includes Iceland, Liechtenstein and Norway) or Swiss citizen? If so, are they aware of that in order for them to remain in the UK they need to complete EUSS documents and submit them to the Home Office. Some people will have lived in the UK for many years, or they may be homeless or in care and don't know that it is now the law to apply to remain here. At the Nottingham Law Centre, they can go through the paperwork with them, but they do need to call now and fix an appointment with one of their solicitors.

Citizens UK are calling on **Nottingham Forest FC** to pay all their employees, including match-day staff, a real Living Wage of £9.50 p/hr. Quite simply, people are not paid enough to live a dignified life. Earning a real Living Wage rather than the minimum wage, it is the difference between living and just surviving. We want our landmark institutions in Nottingham to show leadership on this issue. By paying a real Living Wage, Nottingham Forest FC would be demonstrating their commitment to keeping Nottingham people out of poverty.

Hands on Magdalena Medio, Colombia - Parish Project 2019 -2021

Working with young people and women's support groups in Colombia, to run workshops and equip young people with strong communication skills and other tools to make peace a reality. Young leaders have been trained to bring about change by taking advantage of a unique peace deal between the most notorious guerrilla group and the Colombian government.

This project has now closed and we would like to let you know - the £7,870 you raised has enabled 28 of the 34 schools that CAFOD worked with now have School Coexistence Committees that work to promote a culture of peace and reconciliation. This project has also enabled Cafod to reach 5,748 people across Magdalena Medio.
