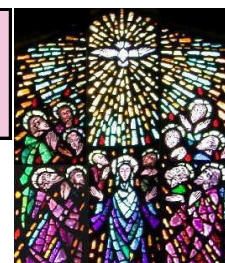

## Masses At The Holy Spirit

Following the Government announcement this week, we await new advice from the Catholic Bishops Conference. However, the Diocese have recommended face coverings are strongly advised indoors and social distancing because of the Delta variant.

You will be able to attend public weekday Masses without booking a place.

However, we kindly ask you use the NHS App and scan your phone on the QR code in church or confirm to a Steward your attendance by giving your name and contact number.

You must sanitize your hands before entering church and wear a mask.
