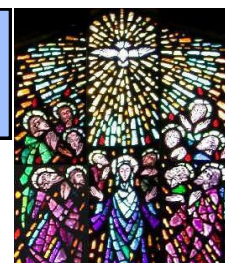

Participation in the Synodal Process

In October Pope Francis formally opened a two-year process called "a synod on synodality," officially known as "Synod 2021-2023: For a Synodal Church." In brief, the process involves **an expansion of an established institution, called the "Synod of Bishops."** This means that bishops around the world will consult with their Parishes asking questions for their parishes to consider.

Bishop Patrick McKinney wrote to parishes in our Diocese to ask them how Parish and chaplaincies can contribute to the Synodal Process. We would like parishioners to respond to the questions that the Synod would like us to consider. The questions are in the porch church and on the parish website :

Help for Refugees and Asylum Seekers in Nottingham



Desperately needed are Men's clothes SIZE SMALL/ MEDIUM (particularly trousers, as tops that are a bit too big can be used, but small trousers - 30", 32" waist, are in particularly short supply). We are heading into some cold weather so thermal vests or other warm tops, thick socks and waterproof coats are going to be needed as well as the usual tee-shirts, jumpers and hoodies.

Trainers - sizes 40,41,42,43 are the most common.

Other items that are asked for include backpacks, safety razors and shaving cream (people are supplied with soap and shampoo), nail clippers and wide-toothed combs/afro combs. Also, things to pass the time so dominoes, playing cards etc.

Women's clothes and toiletries are also needed too.

Children's clothes and shoes are also as well.
